This Invitation For Bid [IFB] for package of STBM Coordinator for Province and STBM Facilitator for District of Pamsimas is also announced on the Pamsimas website (www.pamsimas.org), and Local Newspapers.

The Government of Indonesia intends to apply for a grant through World Bank-managed Fund for the Community Based Water Supply Project (PAMSIMAS II). The Executing Agency, The Directorate General of Communicable Disease and Environmental Health intends to use a portion of the grant to manage the implementation of the activities in provincial and district project implementation units. The scope of the services includes implementation support and development needs guidance of STBM program scale of district wide and provide on the implementation of PAMSIMAS provincial and district/city. STBM Coordinator for Province and District Facilitator STBM for experts is a component of the general duty to apply Pamsimas Health Program Management Guidelines at: Sub Component 2.1: Community-Led Total Sanitation Programme (STBM), Sub Component 2.2: Health and Sanitation Marketing Program and Sub Component 2.3: Units of local hygiene and sanitation, and provide expert support that is different from all levels, ranging from provincial, to district/city.

The selected Service Provider will be responsible for providing technical support to the Project Management Units (PPMUs/Dinas Kesehatan Provinsi and DPMUs/Dinas Kesehatan Kabupaten) and technical teams (Pakem) for implementing the project components in their respective areas, in carrying out the overall project management and monitoring at province, district and village levels including the use of MPA/PHAST as a key approach/ methodology for project implementation, and piloting and promotion of the CLTS approach.

The STBM Coordinator for Province and STBM Facilitator for District is a Time Based Contract to be implemented over a period services of twenty-five (25) months starting September 2014 and completion date is September, 2016.

The Executing Agency now invites eligible Service Providers to submit a post-qualification bid to provide the services (Non-Consulting Services contract). Interested service providers must submit their bids in a single stage-single sealed envelope in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders (ITB). Bidders may associate in the form of a joint venture to enhance their capacity to undertake the work. The above-mentioned provision of services will be selected on the basis of the Lowest Evaluated Responsive Bid and post qualification review in accordance with the procedures set in the World Bank's Procurement Guidelines (January 2011).

The Procurement Committee invites any interested firm to register and obtain a set of bidding documents on Compact Disk (CD) from the Pokja 4, Procurement Committee (ULP), Ditjen PP dan PL Build D, 2th floor, Jl. Percetakan Negara Nomor 29, Salemba, Jakarta Pusat. The bidding document will be available commencing July 4, 2014, during working hours 10.00 am - 16.00 pm.

A prospective Bidder requiring any clarification of the bidding documents may notify the Employer in writing to the Procurement Committee (E-mail: pamsimaskes@gmail.com). The Employer will respond to any request for clarification received earlier than 10 calendar days prior to the deadline for submission of bids. Copies of the Employer's response will be forwarded to all purchasers of the bidding documents, including a description of the inquiry, but without identifying its source.

Bids shall be valid for a period of 90 days after Bid closing and must be accompanied by security of bid [see the following table] or its equivalent in a convertible currency, and shall be delivered to Head of Procurement Committee on or before July 24, 2014, at which time they will be opened in the presence of the bidders who wish to attend.
